

## Registration for Band Courses:

Enloe offers a range of traditional band ensembles (Concert, Symphonic and Wind Ensemble), we also have an amazing jazz program with a Big Band, and multiple Jazz Improvisation Combos. Marching Band at Enloe is not a class, our Marching Band program is co-curricular and rehearses only after school hours.

Our upper level course offerings are honors level courses, which gives the student additional quality points on their GPA. Our Symphonic Band, Wind Ensemble, Advanced Jazz Improv and (New for 2016-17) Big Band courses will provide this additional honors credit.

All of our band programs, like the other Arts classes at Enloe, use an audition process to place students into the correct program based on skills and the instrumentation needs of each class to ensure a great performance experience.

### Quick Answers:

**What class do I sign up for?** The registration system should only present you with one option (Band II). You should select that and it will be updated automatically to the correct course for you after your audition is completed.

**When are these placement auditions?**

**When and How do I sign up for Marching Band?**
